To qualify, your Club must hold two 3Ts Club Competitions, one for men & one for women. The winner of each then joins your Men's & Ladies' Captains to form your Club's 4-person team to compete in one of our finals.

Closing date for team entries is 28 August 2025. Get your Club Competitions in the Club calendar now!

NO INCREASE ENTRY FEES ONLY €10 PER PERSON

All participanting players in 3Ts Club Competitions pay an Entry Fee of only €10. We've kept these entry fees low for you, so, we ask all participating clubs to encourage as many members as possible to enter your Club Competitions.

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

What do you have to do to enter 3Ts Golf Tournament?

Your Club must commit to holding two 3Ts Club Competitions, one men's & one ladies. The two winners then join your Men's & Lady Captains to form your Club's 4-person team to compete against other clubs at one of two world class final venues – the K Club Palmer North Course or Mount Juliet. Each entrant in your Club Competition pays an entry fee of only €10. Every cent counts so we need you to encourage as many members as possible to enter your Club Competition. *Supplement your fundraising with a raffle, donations or your own dedicated club fundraiser.*

- Tournament format throughout is Stableford, full handicaps, two scores to count.
- Entry fee is €10 for each member who plays in the club competitions, men's & ladies.
- Participants must be over 18 years of age.
- If a substitute is required, that substitute must have participated in and paid entry fee to the 3Ts Club Competition.
- Club Competitions can be a separate event or held in conjunction with another club competition. It doesn't have to be a separate event.

So get planning. Get your 3Ts Competition dates in your Club Calendar now and submit your entry by closing date 28 August.



FOLLOW THE RULES

Terms & Conditions - the small print

- Entry open to members of GI registered Golf Clubs in Ireland.
- National Finals will be played under the R&A Rules of Golf.
- Teams consist of Club Captains: Mens & Ladies plus winners of both men's & womens' club competitions.
- 3Ts club competition can be run in conjunction with an existing club event or as a new competition.
- Team names must be submitted to 3Ts by 28 August with completed entry form & entry fees.
- It is a condition of entry that club competition dates of play & number of competitors in both club competitions are submitted to 3Ts on entry form. 3Ts reserve the right to request proof of participant numbers in club competitions.
- All team members must have participated in the club competition and paid their entry fee of €10.
- Minimum age of entry is 18 yrs old.
- Entry fees cannot be put towards club prizes. All entry fees must be donated to 3Ts.
- Participating teams agree to adhere to the Rules & Bye-Laws of their Final Venue Club.

- *Handicaps*: World Golf Handicaps as applied by Golf Ireland to apply.
- *Scoring*: Tournament is an 18-hole stableford event for teams
- Best two net scores at each hole count unless otherwise stated.

- Lowest net score on holes 10-18 and if still a tie
- Lowest net score on holes 13-18 and if still a tie
- Lowest net score on holes 16-18 and if still a tie
- Lowest net score on 18th hole and if still a tie
- Sudden death card play-off starting at Hole no. 1.
- *Prizes:* Players in leading two teams at each Final will receive prizes.

Teams:

- 4-Person Club Team consists of Men's Captain & Lady Captain, together with winners of the two Club Competitions, men's & ladies'.
- 3Ts Club Competition can be run in conjunction with an existing club competition, as each club shall decide.
- Participating team names must be submitted to 3Ts by 28th August, together with entry fees and completed entry form.
- 3Ts reserve the right to ask for proof of number of participating golfers in Club Competitions.
- It is condition of entry that the dates of play of the Club Competitions are submitted to the 3Ts on the entry form accompanied by entry fee.
- Entrants must be 18 years of age or over.
- All team members must have participated in the Club Competition and paid the entry fee of €10.
- Entry fees cannot be put towards club prizes. All entry fees must be sent to 3Ts.
- Participating teams agree to adhere to the Rules & Bye-Laws of their Final Venue Club.
